# DANCE DEFINITIONS

## JAZZ

PDA jazz classes are a combination of basic technique and current styles of commercial dance. Students will learn correct stretching and warm up techniques, dance techniques (including kicks, turns, leaps, etc.) as well as routines in various styles of popular dance like Hip Hop, Funk and Broadway Jazz, just to name a few.

## TAP

PDA tap students will learn tap technique and combinations incorporating various styles from the classic genre of Gene Kelly to the modern Tap Dogs.

## CONTEMPORARY

PDA contemporary is a combination of classical technique with various different forms of free movement and can be combined with all genres of music.

## TECHNIQUE

PDA technique classes are for those who wish to improve their jazz by fine-tuning their technique. Students will learn more advanced technique that will help them to focus on more accurate execution of dance movements. This class is ideal for those who wish to improve their dance skills in jazz or contemporary or are looking for an alternative to ballet classes.

# UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

**The studio colours are black and royal purple.**

## **JAZZ & TECHNIQUE**

Black dance pants/tights or shorts/skirts in the summer months with black or purple fitted t-shirt. Shoes are to be black Jazz Flats or Boots (flats preferred).

## **TAP**

Black dance pants/tights or shorts/skirts in the summer months with black or purple fitted t-shirt. Shoes are to be tan Tap Shoes.

Tap students are asked to please wear street shoes to class and to change into their tap shoes once they are inside the hall.

## **CONTEMPORARY**

Black dance pants/tights or shorts/skirts in the summer months with black or purple fitted t-shirt. No shoes required.

**All students are asked to have their hair neatly tied back and off the face. Clothes are to be fitted as baggy clothes make it difficult to see if students are correctly aligned while performing.**

**A Pointe Dynamic Arts t-shirt is available for purchase and use during classes. The t-shirt is purposely fitted to the body and is recommended for use as per the requirements above. Please contact Monique in regards to price and ordering.**

# TERMS & CONDITIONS

## ATTENDANCE

Parents/Guardians and students need to be fully aware that enrolment at Pointe Dynamic Arts is a commitment for the whole year. Students are expected to attend class each week, except in cases of illness; please inform us by phone if a student is to be absent from class.

Fees will not be refunded for non-attendance except under extreme circumstances, e.g. – long term/serious illness or injury, etc. A formal letter in writing is also required accompanied by a doctor's certificate. If a student is to discontinue attendance at Pointe Dynamic Arts, two weeks notice in writing is required.

## COMPLAINTS

If for any reason you or your child have any concerns with classes at Point Dynamic Arts please do not hesitate to contact us and discuss the problem so it can be resolved as quickly as possible.

## UNIFORM

All students are to adhere to the uniform requirements at all times. Hair is to be neatly tied back and off the face, all jewellery and watches are to be removed before class. No food or drink other than water is permitted during class. Chewing gum is strictly prohibited and is to be disposed of before entering the class.

## PERFORMANCES

Students are encouraged to perform at any opportunity, however if they wish to perform any choreography learnt at Pointe Dynamic Arts students MUST ask permission before doing so. Pointe Dynamic Arts retains ownership of all choreography.

## BEHAVIOUR & SAFETY

Students are expected to be punctual, constant lateness is disruptive to the class and other students. Warm up at the beginning of class is essential to ensure the students are physically prepared to participate safely in class.

Pointe Dynamic Arts creates a fun, safe and friendly learning environment. Bullying or any other kind of disrespectful behaviour will not be tolerated and can result in suspension or expulsion.

No student is to be left unattended while waiting to enter the hall for class. Students, parents and siblings are asked to wait outside the hall until it is time for the student(s) to begin class and also to keep noise levels low, as it is disruptive to the learning of the other students.

Parents are asked to please wait outside the hall to pick up children after class, if any child is to be taken home by someone other than their parent or guardian a phone call before class hours or brief note is required.

Dance is a physical activity and it may be required for a teacher to engage in contact to enable correct alignment or to perform first aid.
